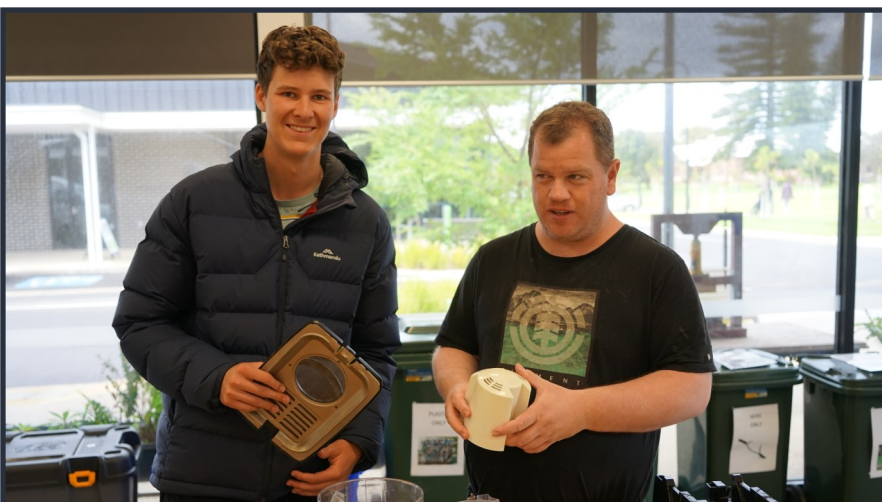

- Show a genuine interest in developing skills and knowledge related to the disability sector
